OUR PRICING POLICY

Parrys International endeavour to ensure that the most up to date and correct prices are shown in our brochure. Occasionally, an incorrect price may be shown, due to an error. When we become aware of any such error, we will endeavour to notify you at the time of booking (if we are then aware of the mistake) or as soon as reasonably possible. We reserve the right to cancel the booking if you do not wish to accept the price which is applicable to the holiday. Local Authorities in many towns and cities throughout Europe have introduced new tourist taxes which should be paid directly to the hotel by all guests in person. However, we try to absorb these extra charges and normally these will be paid by our company.

Holiday prices include all travel, hotel accommodation and meals as specified in the holiday description and VAT payable in the UK where applicable. The Price of the holiday will not be subjected to any surcharges except those arising from exchange rate changes, transportation including the price of fuel, air and ferry operator fares and tolls, embarkation or disembarkation fees at terminals, duties and taxes (including the rate of VAT). If this means the total cost of the holiday increases by more than 8% then you are entitled to cancel your holiday and receive a full refund of all monies paid except any insurance premium and amendment charges. We will communicate the options with you either through email or letter, with a reminder if necessary. If you exercise the right to cancel, we must receive written notice within 20 days of the date of the surcharge invoice. The currency exchange rate used in the holiday costings are based on rates as at the publication date of this Charter.

IF YOU CHANGE YOUR BOOKING

If, after our confirmation has been issued, you wish to change to another of our holidays or change departure date, we will do our utmost to make the changes, but we cannot guarantee to do so. However, notification must be received in writing at our offices from the person who made the booking, at least 10 weeks before departure. This must be accompanied by a payment of £20.00 per person to cover our administration costs, plus costs we incur in making the amendment. Alterations cannot be made within 10 weeks of departure and any such request for an alteration will be treated as a cancellation of the original booking and will be subject to the cancellation charges set out in the paragraph below. Some arrangements cannot be changed without paying a cancellation charge of up to 100% of the ticket cost.

TRANSFERRING YOUR BOOKING

You can transfer your booking to somebody else but the person must satisfy all the conditions of the holiday and you must inform us either by letter or email no less than 7 days before departure. This transfer will cost £20.00 per person plus reasonable costs to make the transfer. You will remain responsible for ensuring payment before the balance due date. This is in addition to (and does not affect) the separate liability of the transferee to us.

IF YOU NEED TO CANCEL YOUR HOLIDAY

You or any member of your party, may cancel your holiday at any time provided that the cancellation is made by the person who made the booking and is communicated to us in writing via the office who made your original booking. You must pay cancellation charges to cover our administration costs and to compensate for the risk of us not reselling the holiday. Your cancellation will take effect from the date on which we or our agent receive your written confirmation of your cancellation.

You must also return any tickets or vouchers you have received. A reduction in room occupancy may increase the charges for the remaining passengers by the application of supplements for low occupancy of rooms. Where bought in supplies, such as ferries, hotel accommodation etc have been bought in on your behalf, and where the terms and conditions of the supplier are non-refundable, these products will be charged to you at the full retail rate. If this applies, the non-refundable items will be deducted from your holiday costs and the following scale of charges will be applied to the remainder:

* On Some tours a 100% cancellation fee is made up to 70 days before departure by the Hotel or provider. Please ask our Reservations Staff for further information.

You may cancel your holiday without paying any termination fee before the start of the holiday, in the event of unavoidable and extraordinary circumstances occurring at the place of destination or its immediate vicinity, for instance, if there are serious security problems at the destination which are likely to affect the package.

ALTERATIONS TO YOUR HOLIDAY BY US

We hope that we will not have to make any change to your holiday but, because our holidays are planned many months in advance, we sometimes do need to make minor changes. We reserve the right to do this at any time. We will let you or your booking agent know about any important changes as soon as possible, including the minimum number of passengers required on the trip.

If after booking, and before departure, we make a major change to your holiday, you will have the option of withdrawing from the holiday without penalty or transferring to another holiday without any charge. In either case, we will pay you compensation according to the scale set out below. A major change includes the time of your departure or return time by more than 12 hours, a change in departure point, location of resort or type of hotel (excluding single overnight hotels on touring packages where the quality of the hotel is comparable), a change in cross channel travel, or specification of the coach. If we tell you about any of these changes after we have confirmed your holiday booking (other than force majeure), you may either:

- accept the new arrangements offered by us; or
- accept a replacement holiday from us of equivalent or similar standard and price (at the date of the change), if we can offer you one; or
- cancel your holiday with us and receive a full refund of all monies

Either way, we will pay you compensation, using the Compensation table shown,

On all our holidays we reserve the right to use either a Ferry or the Channel Tunnel for the short crossing between England and France.

IMPORTANT NOTICE

Compensation will not be payable if the holiday is cancelled because the number of persons booked is less than the number required, or for events beyond our control, which include: war, threat of war, riots, civil disturbances, terrorist activity and its consequences, industrial disputes, natural and nuclear disasters, fire, epidemics, health risks and pandemics, unavoidable and unforeseeable technical problems with transport for reasons beyond our control or that of our suppliers: hurricanes and other actual or potential severe weather conditions, and any other similar events. You are also advised to check with the Foreign and Commonwealth Office Advise Unit regularly at https://www.gov.uk/browse/abroad/travel-abroad prior to travel.

All holidays operate if the minimum number of participants is met. However, in no case will we cancel your holiday less than four weeks before the scheduled departure date, except where you have failed to pay the final balance or because of force majeure (force majeure means an event which we or the suppliers of the services in question could not foresee or avoid and is therefore beyond our control).

OUR RESPONSIBILITY TO YOU

We accept responsibility for ensuring the holiday which you book with us is supplied as described in our publicity material and the services offered reach a reasonable standard and if you are in difficulty, we will assist you. If any part of our holiday contract is not provided as promised, you may terminate the contract without paying a termination fee and we will pay you appropriate compensation if this has affected your enjoyment of your holiday. We will, however, not be liable if there are any unforeseeable or unavoidable actions of a third party not connected with our travel services, (as confirmed in the confirmation invoice and any other information we provided to you regarding the services), or there were unavoidable or extraordinary circumstances, or the lack of conformity is due to a traveller in the party.

We accept responsibility for the acts and/or omissions of our employees, agents and suppliers except where they lead to death, injury or illness. Our liability in all cases shall be limited to a maximum of three times the value of the original holiday cost (not including insurance premiums and amendment charges). We accept responsibility for death, injury, or illness caused by the negligent acts and/or omissions of our employees or agents together with our suppliers and sub-contractors, servants and/or agents of the same whilst acting within the scope of, or during their employment in the provision of your holiday. We will accordingly pay to our clients such damages as might have been awarded in such circumstances under English Law.

In respect of carriage by air, sea, tunnel and rail and the provision of accommodation our liability in all cases will be limited in the manner provided by the relevant international convention.

Bonded Coach Holidays Group Trading Charter and Booking Conditions

If we make any payment to you or any member of your party for death or personal injury or illness, you will be asked to assign to us or our insurers the rights you may have to act against the person or organisation responsible for causing the death, personal injury or illness. This clause does not apply to any separate contracts that you may enter for excursions or activities during or outside of your holiday. If you or any member of your party suffer death, illness or injury whilst overseas arising out of an activity which does NOT form part of your holiday, we may offer guidance and where legal action is contemplated and you want our assistance, you must obtain our written consent prior to any proceedings (We limit the cost of our assistance to you or your party to £5,000 per party).

IF YOU HAVE A COMPLAINT

If you have a problem during your holiday, please inform your Tour Manager, your Driver or the relevant Supplier/Resort Representative immediately who will endeavour to put things right. If your complaint cannot be completely resolved locally, you must complete a Holiday Report Form which can be obtained by your Driver or local Representative, which you should keep. Our contact number, for unresolved complaints will be our office number on: 01922 414576 (open in office hours).

If you remain dissatisfied, please follow this up within 14 days of your return home by writing to our Customer Services Department, Parrys International, Landywood Green, Cheslyn Hay, Walsall, WS6 7QX. Giving your original booking reference number and all other relevant information, including the reference of the Holiday Report Form.

It is therefore a condition of this contract that you communicate any problem to the supplier of the services in question AND to our representative whilst in resort and obtain a written report form. If you fail to follow this simple procedure, we cannot accept responsibility, as we have been deprived of the opportunity to investigate and rectify the problem. Should you wish to pursue the complaint further, BCH/ABTOT have an Alternative Dispute Resolution scheme and full details are available from them. OUR COACHES AND SEATING ARRANGEMENTS

We will always use our reasonable endeavours to provide a coach to the specification in our brochure or advert, but reserve the right to substitute an alternative vehicle should there be unforeseen circumstances. There is a seating plan but, in some cases, operational reasons will require a coach with a different configuration. We reserve the right to alter a coach-seating plan and allocate seats other than those booked. Single passengers may be required to share a double seat with other single

When your booking is confirmed, you will be offered the best seats that are available at that time. If you feel that you require two seats, then these must be booked and paid for in advance, at the time of booking. If you fail to do this and it transpires that the seat allocated to you is insufficient for your needs and there is no alternative seating available then you will be refused access to the coach and any payments made will be liable to forfeiture.

Specific seats will not be allocated on coaches operating a feeder service between joining points and main holiday departure points or on coaches that carry out transfers between airports, seaports etc.

Requests for particular seats other than front seats can be made subject to availability:

- For tours up to 2 nights There are no charges
- For tours 3 to 5 nights £2.50 per seat
- For tours 6 nights and over £5.00 per seat

Front Seats may be reserved, subject to availability, at a supplement (per person) of £2.50 for tours of up to two nights duration, £5.00 for tours of three to five nights duration, £10.00 for tours of six to eight nights and £15.00 for tours of nine nights and over.

We do not allow Children or Single passengers to occupy front seats.

Some hotel facilities and entertainment may be withdrawn for routine maintenance or be subject to seasonal availability and provision of the facilities cannot be guaranteed. Single occupancy of rooms may be subject to a supplementary charge.

In some foreign countries, standards of infrastructure, safety and hygiene may be lower than those to which we are accustomed in the UK. You should therefore exercise greater care for your own protection. There may be countries that we visit that have special medical requirements for tourists. These regulations are subject to change and our clients are responsible for complying with entry and current health requirements. If you are not sure of the health requirements for the country you are visiting, you are advised to check with your own GP before travelling. You are also advised to refer to the Department of Health leaflet "Health Advice for Travellers".

Some people may be at risk from discomfort or deep vein thrombosis (DVT) if they remain immobile on a journey for a long period. If you are planning to undertake a coach journey of more than three hours, you should consult your doctor, if you have ever had DVT, pulmonary embolism, a family history of clotting conditions, cancer or treatment for cancer, stroke, and heart or lung disease or if you have had major surgery in the past three months.

We reserve the right to refuse any booking in the absence of a doctor's certificate confirming that you are fit to travel. Where we provide comfort stops you are encouraged to walk around. Exercise reduces any discomfort, which may be caused by periods of immobility.

SMOKING

No smoking is allowed on our coaches (including E-Cigarettes).

We do not allow pets or any other animals, although we accommodate Registered Assistance Dogs, but

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS, ITINERARIES, PICK UP POINTS AND PASSPORTS

We can only provide general information regarding entry, passport, visa, immigration requirements and safety and health formalities applicable to your package itinerary. It is your responsibility to check such requirements (in good time before departure), in order to make your decisions to fulfil such requirements regarding your destination and/or the country(ies) through which you may be transiting

Such information which you may need to check includes (but is not limited to) passport requirements including (but not limited to) how valid your passport must be after return date, whether your passport must be machine readable, or which visas may be required for entry such as ETA for UK travel and/or

You must check requirements for your own specific circumstances with the relevant bodies as applicable. We have provided a few useful resources below, though it is your responsibility to check and see if such body would be relevant to yourself.

- the Foreign, Commonwealth and Development Office ("FCDO", https://www.gov.uk/travelaware) (applicable to UK residents);
- UK Passport Office 0300 222 0000 or https://www.gov.uk/browse/citizenship.
- Embassies, High Commission and/or Consulates;

For UK residents booking European travel, you should obtain a UK Global Health Insurance Card (UK GHIC) prior to departure unless you are able to rely upon an existing European Health Insurance Card (EHIC). For travel to Norway, Iceland, Liechtenstein and Switzerland, UK GHIC and EHIC cannot be used for medical treatment. Passengers to these destinations should obtain comprehensive medical insurance prior to departure, including cover for emergency medical treatment and associated costs.

We do not accept any responsibility if you cannot travel, or incur any other loss because you have not complied with any entry, passport, visa, immigration requirements or health formalities. You agree to reimburse us in relation to any fines or other losses which we incur as a result of your failure to comply with any entry passport, visa, immigration requirements or health formalities.

You are responsible for ensuring you are at the correct departure point, at the correct time and with the correct documents. Parrys International reserve the right to modify itineraries to conform with requests from competent authorities both within the UK and abroad.

We are unable to delay departures, particularly when Coaches are meeting Feeder Services, collecting other Passengers and travelling to connect with Channel Crossings.

Excursions which are included in the cost of your booking are detailed on the brochure page and refunds will not be made for excursion not taken. Optional excursions booked and paid for in resort do not form part of your booking. Admission fees to buildings may not be included in the price of the holiday, please check.

SPECIAL REQUESTS

All special needs and requests, if agreed, should be included in the confirmation of the holiday. These cannot be guaranteed except where confirmed as part of our holiday commitment to you and are detailed on your holiday booking confirmation. We are keen to ensure that we plan the arrangements for your holiday so that special needs and requests can be accommodated as far as possible. If you will need assistance, or may be unable to fully enjoy all aspects of your holiday you must tell us in advance so that we can maximise your enjoyment of the holiday. We will need to know if you will need special facilities in the hotel, taking part in the excursions or have difficulty boarding and travelling on the coach or other means of transport. Before booking your holiday, you should be sure that you and your party are both physically and mentally capable of completing the itinerary.

If you need advice or further information either you or your booking agent should contact our Reservations Team. If you will require a special diet please tell us at the time of booking, or as soon as you are medically advised, together with a copy of the diet.

We are pleased to pass on all requests to hotels and agents, however please note that they are not guaranteed. All requests must be made with Parrys International and never with the Hotel direct.

PASSENGERS WITH DISABILITIES

Please note our tours are not suitable for clients with health conditions or walking difficulties. We are unable to carry any wheelchairs or walking frames on any of our continental tours.

We want everyone to enjoy our travel arrangements. We are happy to advise and assist you in choosing a suitable holiday. Is important that, when booking, you advise us of any disability, specific need or complex need you may have and any special requirements that will make sure the holiday is suitable. If a passenger requires personal assistance (for example, assistance with feeding, dressing, toileting, mobilising) then this passenger must travel with an able-bodied companion or carer and written confirmation that such assistance will be provided for the entirety of the holiday is required at the time of booking. Coach Drivers/Tour Managers are unable to provide such assistance.

You must tell us if you have any existing medical condition, disability or complex need that may affect your holiday or other group members' enjoyment of it, before you book your holiday. We reserve the right to request a doctor's certificate confirming the passenger is fit to travel. If, in our reasonable opinion, your chosen holiday is not suitable for your medical condition or disability, we reserve the right to refuse your booking. You are responsible for bringing with you the proper clothing and equipment, which we advise you about in our printed trip information. We want you to enjoy your holiday and will help you select an appropriate trip.

There is very limited availability for wheelchairs. Request for carriage must be made at the time of reservation. We are unable to carry Electric Wheelchairs or Scooters.

We want all our customers to have a happy and carefree holiday. You are responsible for your behaviour and hygiene and the effect it may have on others. If you or any member of your party is abusive, disruptive or behaves in a way that could cause damage or injury to others or affect their enjoyment of their holiday or which could damage property, we have the right to terminate your contract with us and we will have no further liability or obligation to you.

The coach driver/representative, Ships Captain, or Similar, authorised official is entitled to refuse you boarding if in their reasonable opinion you are unacceptably under the influence of drink or drugs or you are being violent or disruptive. If you are refused boarding on the outward journey, we will regard it as a cancellation by you and we will apply cancellation charges. If on your return journey, we have the right to terminate the contract with you. We ask you to be considerate when using Mobile Devises.

TRAVEL INSURANCE

Whilst we no longer arrange travel insurance policies, Travel insurance is compulsory on all European holidays (including any tours travelling to the Republic of Ireland). Although not compulsory on UK holidays it is strongly recommended. The insurance should cover medical and repatriation costs, personal injury, loss of baggage and cancellation charges. If you do not have adequate insurance and require our assistance during your holiday, we reserve the right to reclaim from you any medical repatriation or other expenses which we may incur on your behalf which would otherwise have been met by insurers.

Please note that it is your responsibility to be in procession of the correct travel insurance documents when you travel, which should include details of the insurer, the policy number, the name and 24-hour contact number of the emergency medical assistance service.

LUGGAGE

Please restrict your luggage to a suitcase weighing no more than 18kgs per person. We suggest one medium suitcase per person plus one small overnight bag. Should you bring over this amount of Luggage, we cannot be held liable should there not be enough room on the Coach. We cannot accept responsibility for loss or damage to luggage unless through our negligence. Please do not leave valuable items in your suitcase when left on the coach.

It is the Client's responsibility to ensure that luggage is loaded onto all coaches. You must attach issued Luggage Labels to all items.

Any Luggage claim should be pursued with your travel insurance provider.

CONDITIONS OF SUPPLIERS

Many of the services which make up your holiday are provided by independent suppliers. Those suppliers provide these services in accordance with their own terms and conditions which will form part of your contract with us. Some of these terms and conditions may limit or exclude the supplier's liability to you, usually in accordance with applicable International Conventions. Copies of the relevant parts of these terms and conditions are available on request from us or the supplier concerned.

ADVANCED PASSENGER INFORMATION

A number of Governments are introducing new requirements for our suppliers to provide personal information about all travellers to the Authorities prior to travellers arriving at the destination. The data will be collected either at the time of or after a booking is made. Where we collect this data, we will treat it in accordance with our Privacy Policy.

EMERGENCY CONTACT

In the event of an emergency occurring outside normal office hours please call our 24-Hour emergency telephone number for further assistance and advice – 07831 099988.

Remember this number is strictly for emergencies only.

Holiday Information

HOW TO BOOK AND CONFIRMATION OF RESERVATIONS

To make a reservation simply telephone our office to check availability or check our website online. Read our TRADING CHARTER, FINANCIAL STATEMENT, ITINERARY and send your deposit/full payment. No booking can be confirmed until a deposit is paid. Credit or debit card payment can secure a booking immediately.

PAYMENT BY CHEQUE

When making any payment by Cheque, please write the name of the person and the booking reference number on the back of the Cheque. Cheques should be made payable to 'Parrys International Tours Ltd'. We do NOT accept postdated cheques.

ACCOMMODATION

Individual hotel details show if facilities include air-conditioning and passenger lifts. Certain items in hotels such as saunas and solariums may incur charges. Some hotels have accommodation in separate buildings to the main hotel complex. Many hotels hold functions that may cause extra noise. Unfortunately, this is beyond our control. Due to traffic restrictions some Hotels cannot be accessed by Coach and a short walk maybe involved i.e. Hotel Sole – Riva Del Garda, Hotel Felsenkeller Rüdesheim. In these circumstances we will normally transfer luggage to the Hotel.

FERRY ACCOMMODATION

Accommodation on Overnight Ferries is normally a 2-Berth inside Cabin with Bunk Beds. All Cabins have Private Facilities.

DOUBLE & TRIPLE ROOMS

Requests may be made for a double-bedded room in preference to a twin room. However, requests are forwarded to the hotels and rooms allocated at the hotelier's discretion. Many 'twin-bedded' rooms on the continent have the appearance of being a double. There are in fact one or two mattresses and separate duvets.

Triple rooms are limited and normally consist of a double bed and a fold-away bed. We do not advise the reservation of a triple room for three adults. In all Novotel Hotels all rooms have one double bed and one sofa bed.

SEA, POOL OR LAKE VIEW - ROOM UPGRADES

On selected tours and for an additional fee, you may be able to upgrade your room. Please note that the specific view may vary from lateral to frontal and obstructions such as trees or other buildings may be present and are beyond our control. Any upgrades must be confirmed with our reservations team at the time of booking.

PORTERAGE

Please note that porterage at hotels is not included. You may however ask your driver for assistance.

MEALS - WHEN INCLUDED

British tours: We normally offer a choice menu on British tours – English Cooked Breakfast is included and Evening Meals are Buffet style or table d'hote with tea or coffee served afterwards unless stated otherwise.

European tours: Breakfast is usually a Continental Buffet, while Dinner is normally a three-course set menu and all drinks including tea and coffee charged as extras.

Some tours require set meal times and individual tables are normally not available. All Hotels request that no items are taken away from the Restaurant.

RESORT DEVELOPMENT

In many resorts improvements and building work take place in the summer months. Changes can happen very quickly and we will try to advise you of work that may take place in your resort destination.

ENTERTAINMENT

Some of our hotels arrange additional entertainment. Where this is part of the package details are given on the respective brochure page. Where it is not specified it may still be available but is at the discretion of the hotel and is not guaranteed. It may be withdrawn if there is a lack of demand or for operational reasons.

EXCURSIONS & FACILITIES

We reserve the right to cancel any optional excursions due to low numbers. Due to regulations governing driving hours it may be necessary to alter the order of excursions or cancel excursions. Optional excursion prices are subject to alteration if costs involved are changed. Please remember that some amenities (e.g. hotel lifts, swimming pools, etc) require servicing and cleaning and may not therefore be available at all times. Some services may be affected by weather conditions and their availability is entirely at the discretion of the provider of the service.

CHII DREN

In our opinion the coach tours featured in our brochure are unsuitable for young children. A reduction maybe applicable to children under 12 and applies when sharing a room with two full fare-paying adults. All child prices are available on request.

PICK UP TIMES

Please note we cannot delay any departure due to late arrivals at pick-up points. Remember there are often long periods of coach travel. Early departures are often required to meet reasonable arrival times. On our 5-day programs, coaches depart early on Friday morning for the return journey often non-stop.

TOUR INFORMATION

Approximately one week prior to your departure you will receive optional excursion prices, pre-printed luggage labels and a travel ticket confirming your pick-up time. These are strictly posted to the lead address only.

DADKING

Limited parking spaces are available at our Landywood Green premises, at a supplement of £10.00 per day. Parking must be pre-booked through our Reservations Office.

JOINING POINTS

It is a firm company policy that passengers are set down at their original joining points only.

FEEDER SERVICES

Feeder services are often used to reduce pick up times. These can be operated by other Tour Coaches or small mini-Coaches or even Cars. Please be aware that these may be different vehicles and may not have our normal facilities on board.

COACHES

All our fleet of tour coaches have telephone communication. Seat belts are fitted to all seats and our music is licensed by the Performing Rights Society. We reserve the right to sub-contract coaches at any time and the specification and facilities may differ to that detailed in our Brochure or Website. When operating low loaded tours, it may be necessary to use smaller vehicles. Please note due to electrical connections under all seats, bags or bulky items should not be stored under seats or on the floor. Storage is available in the overhead lockers – Size restrictions apply.

DRINKS ONBOARD

Please note for safety reasons hot drinks should not be brought onto Coaches from services or any other outlet. Our own hot drinks fit into our drop-down tables.

CCTV

All our Coaches are fitted with CCTV Cameras. These record both images and sound for the added safety and security of our passengers and crew. These can be used for crime prevention and the prosecution of criminals.

FRONT & CENTRE STEPS

Please be aware that the front and centre steps leading to the toilet and exit are quite steep and protrude into the main gangway. All clients are advised to be extra cautious. Please do not use Coach Toilets unless on a Motorway journey and is safe to do so and never when standing or on normal roads and or maneuvering.

CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

Parrys International conditions of carriage require that no person may be permitted to drink alcoholic beverages at any time aboard the coach unless served by a member of staff.
